

Carrying Out a Home Visit

The following example is designed to give guidance only and does not constitute an accurate risk assessment for any activity.

Physical Hazards might include:

- **Manual Handling**
- Driving
- Weather/Environment
- Client
- People handling
- Client environment
- Animals

Chemical Hazards might include:

- Any substances used by employee
- Any substances present in clients premises

Biological Hazards might include:

- Human waste
- **Animal Waste**
- Drug paraphernalia
- **Body fluids**

Psychological Hazards might include

Verbal Abuse#

Risks would include

Remember that the initial risk levels are set without controls in place. In this particular case it is not possible to set the risk level for specific risks without knowledge of the existing hazards. (Note 'specific to client') it is assumed that anyone carrying out such a visit would be able to assess these risks and rate the level accordingly (for the purpose of the example assessment below we have decided on a medium risk level from client)

Physical

- Manual Handling loading or unloading items into vehicles or clients premises (Med)
- Driving to and from location (low)
- Weather/Environment incident due to weather conditions or from the physical environment
- Client Physical abuse from client (specific to client)
- People handling injury from moving/lifting client (High)
- Client environment injury from hazards in client's premises (faulty electrical equipment, trip hazards etc) (specific to client)
- Animals contact with clients pets or stray animals in general environment (specific to client)



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Chemical

- Any substances used by employee contact or exposure to substance (Med)
- Any substances present in clients premises contact or exposure to substance (Med)

Biological

- Human waste contact or exposure (specific to client)
- Animal Waste contact or exposure (specific to client)
- Drug paraphernalia needle stick injuries (specific to client)
- Body fluids contact or exposure (specific to client)

Psychological

Verbal Abuse – stress through being subjected to abuse (specific to client).

Who will be affected?

This again will very much depend on the activity being undertaken. It may well be that there is only the employee affected, employee and client or employee/s and others (related helpers etc).

Risk levels

The risk levels would be decided by the assessor based on all information that they have: i.e. if the client had a known tendency to violence then the risk level would obviously be high.

Whereas a known client who always has you cup of coffee waiting for you would be low.

Controls

- Manual Handling Ensure that those involved in object handling have received appropriate level of training and that any necessary mechanical aids are available and used.
- Driving Ensure vehicle is fit for purpose and Highway code is followed.
- Weather/Environment Take advice on whether weather conditions are suitable for planned trip.
- Client Take precautions in line with any known info on client. (two person visit etc).
- People handling Ensure that those involved in people handling have received appropriate level of training and that any necessary mechanical aids hoists etc are available and used.
- Client environment Assess (where practicable) hazards within clients premises.
- Animals Ensure that any aggressive animals are secured in separate area before entering client's premises.
- Any substances used by employee ensure COSHH assessment is available and that employee is aware of risks to self and others.
- Follow safe working procedure and use appropriate PPE.

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- Any substances present in client's premises ensure COSHH assessment is available and that employee is aware of risks to self and others. Follow safe working procedure and use appropriate
- Human waste Follow Hygiene procedures for service.
- Animal Waste Follow Hygiene procedures for service.
- Drug paraphernalia Follow procedure for service.
- Body fluids Follow Hygiene procedures for service.
- Verbal Abuse Act on any known info on client. Follow procedure for service.

Example Assessment

The example assessment below is intended as guidance and does not reflect any activity carried out. In general it will require a degree of knowledge of any specific activity and existing service procedures before an accurate assessment can be undertaken.
