WorkPlus is an employability programme, designed to give you the skills and experience you need to find a job



Programme Overview

Step 1 - Apply for the programme

If you are interested in applying for the programme, you will be given the opportunity to complete a job application form.

Step 2 – Employability skills session

If your application is successful, you will then be invited along to an employability skills session, where you'll undergo interview skills training. You'll also get feedback on your application form for the programme.

Step 3 – Interview

The next stage will be an interview with the service area that you will be working in. The interview will give you the chance to put your employability skills training into practice.

Step 4 – Paid internship

The final step is to start the paid internship. You will be employed by Aberdeenshire Council for the duration of the internship which lasts for 8 weeks, and you will work towards a real job description. You'll get hands on experience of a real working environment, which should help increase your chances of getting a paid job in the future.
